



LimonCello Drink Menu



HARVEST MARTINI

Muddle 3 slices Apple, 0.5 parts fresh lemon juice, and 0.5 parts Tuaca
Splash of simple syrup
Ice
1 part Whiskey
1 part Limoncello
1.5 part Cranberry juice
Shake & Strain into a chilled martini glass
Garnish with a floating apple slice



TENNESSEE GINGER

Ice
1 oz Whiskey
0.5 oz Ginger Liqueur
0.5 oz Limoncello
1 oz Fresh lemon juice
Shake & Dump
Fill with 75% Club Soda, 25% Ginger Ale
Garnish with a thin lemon half-moon, and a small candied ginger slice



FRENCH LEMONDROP

Ice
1 oz Lemon Vodka 0.5 oz
Limoncello 0.25 oz
Raspberry liqueur
1 oz Fresh lemon juice 0.5 oz
Simple syrup
Shake & Strain into a sugar rimmed martini glass Garnish
with a floating lemon wheel



RASPBERRY MINT TEA

Muddle 5-6 Mint Leaves, 3 Raspberries & .5 oz simple syrup
Ice
1 oz Raspberry Vodka
1 oz Limoncello
1 oz Fresh lemon juice
0.5 oz Simple Syrup
Shake & Dump, Add Ice
Fill iced tea
Garnish with a mint sprig and/or a half lemon moon



DOMINO

Ice
3 oz Gin
1 oz Vodka
0.5 oz Limoncello
Shake & Strain into a chilled martini glass
Garnish with a thin lemon peel
Note: This drink is inspired by James Bonds drink the Vesper, instead of Lillet we use Limoncello



PRICKLY PEAR LEMONADE

Ice
1 oz Vodka
1 oz Limoncello
1.5 oz Fresh lemon juice
0.5 oz Prickly pear juice (less if syrup)
0.25 oz (or to taste) simple syrup
Shake & Dump, Add Ice (Club Soda, optional)
Garnish half lemon moon



SUMMER SUNDAY

Splash simple syrup
Raspberries & blueberries, muddled
Ice
1 oz Gin
1 oz Limoncello
0.5 oz Fresh lemon juice
Shake & Dump, Add Ice
Fill with club soda
Garnish with a thin lemon peel



MEYERS CUBRA LIBRA

Ice
1 oz Rum
1 oz Limoncello
Shake & Dump, Add Ice
Fill with Coca-Cola
Garnish with a half of a lemon moon



VANILLA LIMONCELLO PRESS

Ice
1 oz Vanilla Vodka
0.5 oz Limoncello
0.5 oz Tuaca (possibly just a splash)
Shake & Dump, Add Ice
Fill with 75% Club Soda, and 25% Sprite
Garnish with a thin lemon peel



SHANDY

1 oz Limoncello, or 1 oz Arancello
Squeeze of fresh lemon juice
Added to beer (wheat beers & light lagers are best, preferably a pint)
Note: Limecello added to south of the border style beers
